#### 18" Water Line - Galliano to Cut Off:

The Contractor is NCMC, LLC, with a contract amount of \$5,357,000.00. The current contract amount (through Change Order No. 2) is \$5,792,128.24. The Notice to Proceed was issued for January 29, 2024, with a completion date of January 22, 2025. The project was declared to be Substantially Complete on November 8, 2024.
