### Waterline Replacement Along Savoie Street (CWEF Grant)

We anticipate receiving funds for this project within the next month and approving bids at next month's meeting.

### Booster Station Rehabilitations

Valentine Booster Station - Valves have been installed allowing us to isolate the station. Isolation valves and the check valve for Pump #3 have been installed. Plan preparation for additional work is underway, which includes pipe replacement in the station and rehab of existing piping and valves to remain.

Cut Off Booster Station - CSI Services is the Contractor for this project. Pump isolation valves have been replaced and interior piping is currently being sandblasted and painted.




